- ✓ All Before and After school balances need to be paid by Friday, June 9th. Your child will not be enrolled in summer camp with a past due balance.
- ✓ Families will receive monthly field trip permission calendars highlighting the activities and field trips. Please be sure to read each calendar carefully and return a signed copy to SFQCC.
- ✓ Label all belongings with your child's name.
 - A labeled reusable water bottle
 - Two changes of clothes in a labeled Ziplock gallon sized bag
- ✓ SFQCC is not responsible for toys, games, or other personal belongings brought from home. Please refrain from bringing unnecessary items to the program.
- ✓ Children must wear closed toe shoes EVERYDAY!
- ✓ Call before 8:30 am if your child will not be joining us that day.
- ✓ Arrive before 10:30 each day to ensure lunch counts are accurate (apart from field trip days—we may depart as early as 9:00 am).
- ✓ Earliest drop-off is 6:00 am and latest pick-up is 6:00 pm (please be mindful of our 10-hour rule).
- ✓ Teachers only apply sunscreen in the afternoons if a signed waiver is on file (see enrollment packet).
- ✓ Families are responsible for timely payments throughout the summer program. Space in the program is limited; late payments will be subject to fees and termination from the program if necessary.
- ✓ All field trip dates are tentatively scheduled. Finalized dates will be written in each monthly permission calendar. Students must arrive **BEFORE** 9:00 am to attend the scheduled field trip or be placed in a preschool program for the duration of the field trip.

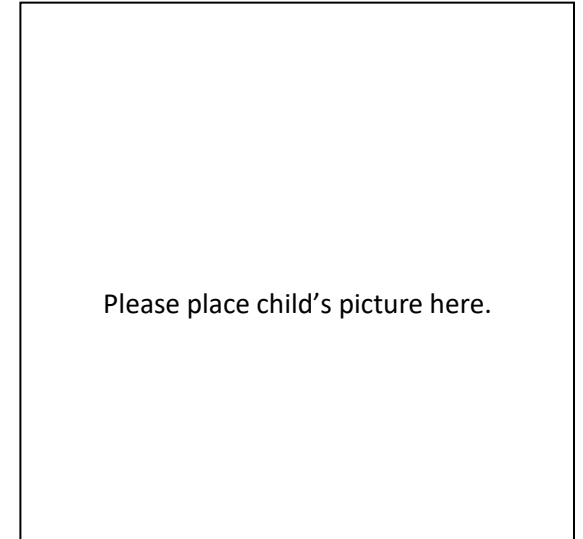

SUNSCREEN WAIVER

It's that time of year again for strong North Carolina sunshine and the potential for sunburn! We ask that all families apply sunscreen to their children before arriving at the center. Before going outside in the afternoon, SFQCC staff will apply sunscreen to all children who have a signed waiver (please see attached).

The first waiver is to use a generic brand, *Equate Sport* SPF 50, each afternoon before your child's scheduled outdoor time. If your child has skin sensitivity, you may choose to use the second waiver and provide your own sunscreen. Please be sure to fill out the waiver completely with specific brand names and dates. Again, this sunscreen will be applied each

afternoon before your child's scheduled outdoor time.

Please return your sunscreen waiver as soon as possible. The day we receive the waiver is the day we can start applying sunscreen! We cannot apply sunscreen to children who do not have a waiver on file. Personal sunscreen and waivers that become expired must be replenished to continue application.

Personal sunscreen bottle considerations: No aerosol containers, No scented lotions, Up to 8 fl. oz. bottle, Child's name must be clearly labeled on masking tape in permanent ink, and a waiver must match information on the sunscreen bottle

Medication Administration Permission for Over-the-Counter Topical Medications and Fluoridated Toothpaste

Parent/guardian must authorize staff to apply over-the-counter, topical ointments, topical teething ointment or gel, insect repellents, lotions, creams, powders and fluoridated toothpaste. Sunscreen and baby lotion are examples. Only accept items in their original containers and clearly labeled with the child's name. Keep insect repellents in locked storage and all other items out of reach of children when not in use.
